

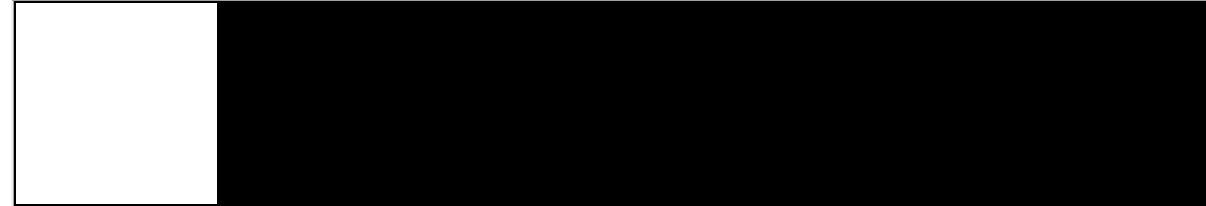

22. Determination of penalty, if majority finds Accused guilty on one or more charges
23. Accused called back and advised of result
